Dear Parent,

In preparation for the 2019-2020 school session, I am writing to inform you of the immunization requirements for school attendance for children entering the 6th grade.

Students 11 years of age and entering the 6th grade are required by state law to show proof of having received a second dose of Varicella (Chickenpox) vaccine, one dose of Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Acellular Pertussis) vaccine, and one dose of MCV4 (Meningococcal) vaccine.
